### Incoming 7th Grade Vaccination Needed

All students entering 7th grade next school year will need proof of a Tdap booster shot before starting school. This requirement:

- Began July 1, 2011
- Can be met by receiving one dose of Tdap vaccine on or after the 10th birthday (the Tdap can be accepted if given on or after the 7th birthday, but the vaccine is generally not recommended this early)
- Can NOT be satisfied by a Td booster or having history of the disease
- Applies to both public and private schools.

In addition, children who leave out of Kings County anytime during the summer of 7th grade will also need a TB skin test.

### Kindergarden Oral Exam

Oral Health Exam information was sent home to Kindergarten students in need of an Oral Exam. Please make an appointment immediately to get your students check-up. Form is due to the office on May 30, 2014.

### Mandatory Health Screening for incoming 1st graders

California's Health and Safety Code 124085 requires a comprehensive health screening for Grades K-1 to be completed and presented to the school nurse within 18 months prior to entry into first grade or within 90 days thereafter.

If we do not have proof of a physical, a document that needs to be completed by your doctor was sent home with your student last week. Please return this document to Valerie in the office as soon as it is completed.
