Please keep in mind that those students who are not on the team are not allowed to stay behind during practice or games unless a parent is with them. The Coaches are only responsible for the athletes on the team. On away games players are allowed to ride the bus to and from the games. If you give permission for your student to ride home with another player, a note must be given to the coach. This is for the safety of our students. On away games days, students are expected back to Kit Carson at approximately a 1/2 hour after the last game. Please plan to pick up your athlete.

Office Information

For the safety of our students, ALL parents, grandparents, and guests must check-in the office upon entering the school grounds to sign in and to receive a visitors badge. No matter what the reason is for your visit, every person needs to check in with the office. If you are seen on the grounds without a visitors pass, you will be asked to go to the front office to check in. If you are picking up any student, you must stand in viewing sight of the office staff. Please do not stand in the hallway. For the safety of students and staff, EVERY VISITOR MUST check in the office.

Parents are welcome and encouraged to visit the school. Visits should be scheduled with the teacher in advance in order to make the visit as productive as possible. Advanced notice also minimizes disruption to the classroom. In the interest of safety, all visitors must check in at the office upon their arrival on campus and prior to visiting a classroom.

NEW Halloween Costume Rules

Due to the safety issues and to academic time in the classrooms, new rules for costumes has been put into effect.

- Students must follow the school dress code
- Students may not bring makeup or hair spray to school
- Students may bring costumes that easily fit over clothing, such as masks, wigs, hats, capes, etc.
- Students may not change into costumes at school.

Phone Calls
