Bringing 25% of Students Back

California schools have been provided guidance from the California Department of Public Health to provide targeted, specialized support at school. We will be inviting a small cohort of students (Special Education and English learners) back to school 1 day per week for 2 hours. Each student invited will receive information regarding their specific day and time for services. Parents of students invited do not have to send their student if they do not want their student to attend. These services will begin Tuesday, September 22, 2020. (Unless the California Department of Public Health changes the rules between now and then).
